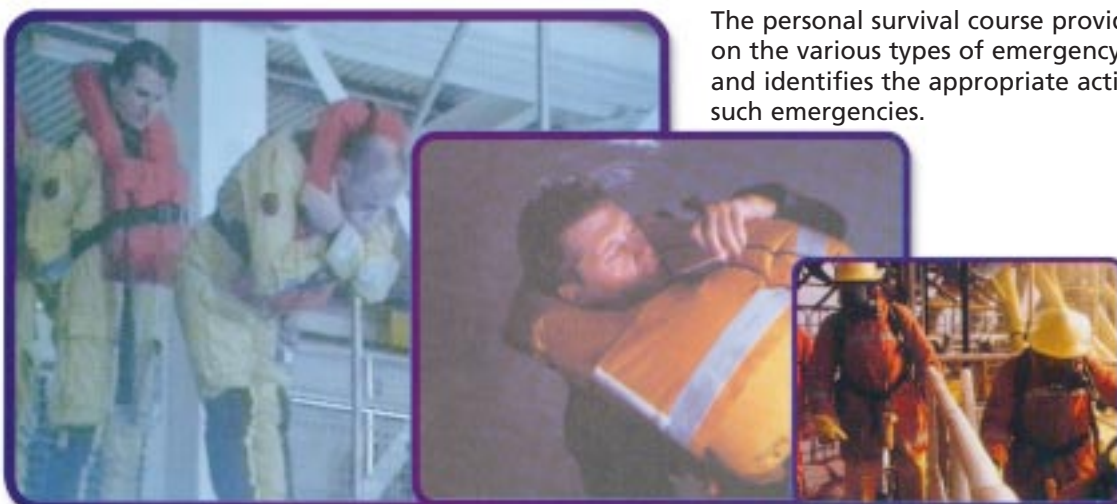
Familiarisation

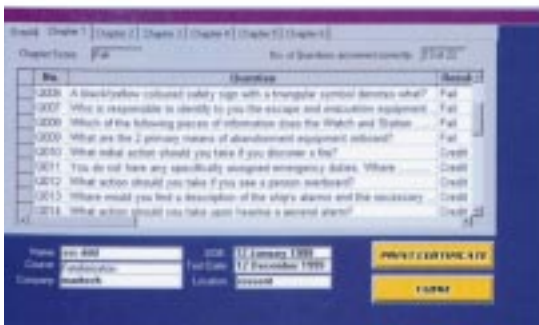
